I hereby make application for a special registration plate in accordance with Act 391, approved August 13, 1963, amending Section 702 of the Vehicle Code. This Act requires that for each special registration plate, there shall be paid an additional fee in an amount equal to the fee for the annual registration of such motor vehicle. Passenger motor vehicles \$10.00, plus an additional fee of \$10.00, or a total charge of \$20.00. Station Wagons \$12.00, plus an additional fee of \$12.00, or a total charge of \$24.00.

NOTE: If vehicle is of the passenger type, filing fee of \$10.00 must accompany this application. If vehicle is of Station Wagon type, filing fee of \$12.00 must be attached. Instructions will follow as to when balance of fee is to be paid.

Separate application must be filed for each special registration plate.

Application must be filed with Department before January 15 to assure issuance before expiration date of previous years plate. When application is filed on or after January 15, applicant must procure a license plate from the regular series of plates. When the special plate is received from the manufacturer, it will be issued without additional charge, however, the regular series plate must be returned to the Department.

Special registration plates will be manufactured on the basis of this application.

No refund of additional fee when applicant cancels request after order is placed with manufacturer.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Special registration plates may not contain more than five numbers or letters and numbers in combination.
2. Selections must be made from the following combinations:
 - (a) Four or five numbers.
 - (b) Two, three or four numbers followed or preceded by a single initial.
(the letters I, O or Q may not be used in this series.)
 - (c) One, two or three numbers preceded or followed by two initials.
(the letters I, O or Q may not be used in this series when such letters immediately precede or follow the numerals)
 - (d) One or two numbers preceded or followed by three initials.
(the letters I, O or Q may not be used in this series when such letters immediately precede or follow the numerals) ;
 - (e) When two or three letters are used, they may not be separated by numbers and similarly, numbers may not be separated by letters.
3. Radio and Television stations will be issued special plates containing the station call letters assigned by F.C.C.
4. No special registration plates will be duplicated, except when defaced or lost. In such cases the charge for replacement will be \$1.00. In addition, so that the vehicle may be legally operated pending receipt of the duplicated plate, application must be made for reissue of a plate from the regular series for which there will be a charge of \$1.00.
5. Requests for special registration plates are restricted to passenger vehicles and station wagons.
6. The Department reserves the right to limit or reject certain requests.
